

ORDINANCE NO. 142

ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE USE OF
FIREARMS IN THE TOWN OF EMPIRE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF EMPIRE THAT THE PUBLIC NECESSITY AND CONVENIENCE REQUIRES THE RESTRICTION AND REGULATION OF THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS AND AIR RIFLES WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF EMPIRE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful to discharge any firearm or air gun or BB gun within the limits of the Town; provided, that this ordinance shall not be construed to prohibit any officer of the law to discharge a firearm in the performance of his duty; nor to prohibit any citizen to discharge a firearm when lawfully defending his personal property.

Section 2: Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$5 nor more than \$200 for each offense.

Section 3: If any part or parts of this ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 4: This ordinance, immediately upon its final passage, shall be recorded in the Town Book of Ordinances, kept for that purpose, authenticated by the signature of the Mayor and the Clerk, and shall be published in the Clear Creek Mining Journal, which is a legal newspaper published in Idaho Springs, Colorado, (there being no legal newspaper published in The Town of Empire) and determined to be of general publication in said Town of Empire.

Section 5: This ordinance is necessary to protect and preserve the public health, safety, and convenience and general welfare and shall be in force and effect immediately after passage and final publication.
